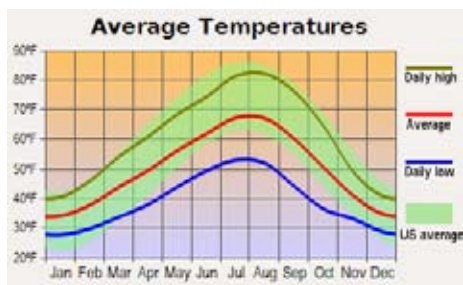
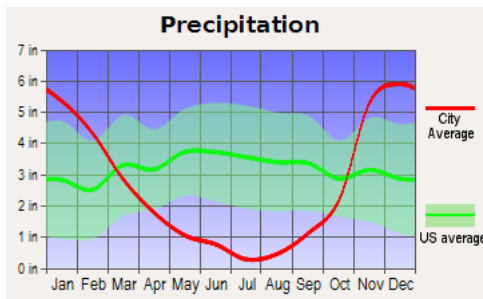

HISTORY

- 1881 Mt. Hood Hotel was built as a stop on the transcontinental railroad.
- 1907 Charles and Ola Bell purchased the hotel for \$35,000.
- 1912 The current brick portion of the hotel was built as an annex to the wooded Mt Hood Hotel.
- 1998 After many years of disrepair, Pasquale and Jacquie Barone fully restored the vintage hotel to it's glory years of the early 1900's.
- 2000 Brian and Penny Cunninghame purchased the hotel and continue to operate it in the same warm and inviting traditions that were started by Charles and Ola Bell more than a century ago.
